Started the Girls Get Healthy program, a partnership with NYC girls' schools, providing weekly school health education, sexual education and cooking classes – for credit. By 2010, the program was in eight charter girls' schools,

including the Young Women Leadership Schools, in Brooklyn, Queens, the Bronx, and Manhattan, with one school in Philadelphia, reaching over 1200 girls yearly. Additionally, educational programs/fundraisers on the neuroscience of body image were run at Lenox Hill Hospital, the Chapin School, and other venues. A roster of volunteer physicians – including gynecologists and paid consultant nutritionists and dance therapists were deployed to work at the schools. The Council dissolved in 2017, with the majority of funds disbursed to Planned Parenthood and the rest to women's health programs.
